

## **INTERIM ALATEEN COORDINATOR ASSEMBLY REPORT (May 10,2025)**

\*Jane P, the AREA CHAIR has asked me to step in as interim Alateen Coordinator.

\*There are 9 Alateen meetings in Massachusetts. They are located in Brewster, Canton, Lynnfield, Millbury, Northampton, Oak Bluffs, Westborough, Worcester and include a brand new meeting in Barnstable

\*There has been interest from the districts that include Hull, Cambridge, Concord, and Beverly. As interim Alateen coordinator, I will be reaching out to see what I can do to help create meetings in these areas.

\*There will be an AMIAS certification online zoom meet scheduled for May 20 at 7pm.

\*Thought is being put into creating an available forum for AMIAS to communicate and reach out to one another.

\*There are about 14 re-certifications that still need to complete an AMIAS workshop. These re-certifications need to attend (1) the May assembly AMIAS meeting (hybrid) or (2) the May 20th AMIAS zoom meeting to ensure re-certification.

\*There are about 4 re-certifications that still reference checks from DRs. Without these we cannot move forward with recertification.

\* The Alateen certification/recertification process with WSO has to be completed by June 15.

\*The May 20th AMIAS meeting will be the last one held to satisfy present applicants.

\*I will begin working in cooperation with AA Liaison Coordinator to begin a relationship with AA in MA to encourage Alateen awareness.

\*Any contributions given to the area for Alateen go into the general fund.
